

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed bids addressed to City of Conway will be received at the Mayor's Office, Conway City Hall, Conway, Arkansas (1201 Oak Street, Conway, Arkansas 72032), until 10:00 am, Tuesday, August 7, 2007, then opened and publicly read aloud, for furnishing all labor, material, and equipment, and performing all work required for DOWNTOWN CONWAY SIDEWALK RENOVATION - OAK STREET - FRONT STREET TO CHESTNUT STREET. The work includes removal and replacement of approximately 650 feet of concrete sidewalk and curb along with the installation of wheel chair ramps, curb inlets, storm drainage pipe and related work.

Proposals shall be accompanied by surety in an amount not less than five per cent (5%) of the total maximum bid price payable without recourse to City of Conway, Arkansas as a guarantee that the Bidder will enter into a contract and execute performance and payment bonds within ten (10) days after notice of award of Contract to him. The notice of award of Contract shall be given by the Owner within sixty (60) days following the opening of bids.

The successful Bidder must furnish a performance bond and a separate payment bond upon the forms provided in the amount of one hundred per cent (100%) of the contract price from an approved surety company holding a permit from the State of Arkansas to act as surety, or other surety or sureties acceptable to the Owner.

The attention of bidders is called to the fact that Act 150 of 1965 (as amended), Arkansas Statutes, states that a Contractor must be licensed by the State Licensing Board for Contractors before he may undertake work when the cost thereof in Arkansas is Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) or more.

Plans, specifications, proposal forms and other contract documents may be examined and obtained at the Mayor's Office, Conway City Hall, 1201 Oak Street, Conway, Arkansas and purchased for \$35.00 per set.

Proposals will be considered on the basis of cost, the bidder's financial responsibility, his equipment, and his past performance in completing similar work. The City of Conway reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities, and to accept the proposal deemed to be for their best interest.
