

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed bids addressed to City of Conway will be received at the Mayor's Office, Conway City Hall, Conway, Arkansas (1201 Oak Street, Conway, Arkansas 72032), until 10:00 am, Wednesday, June 5, 2013, then opened and publicly read aloud, for furnishing all labor, material, and equipment, and performing all work required for City of Conway 2013 Sidewalk Improvements. The work includes the construction of approximately 9,200 feet of 5 foot wide concrete sidewalk along with the installation of wheel chair ramps, concrete driveways and related work along the west side of South German Lane from Robins Street to Dave Ward Drive; along the south side of Timberpeg Court and Bruce Street from Hubbard to Salem Road; along the west side of Shasta Drive from Bruce Street to Timberpeg Court; and along south side Siebenmorgen Road from Bob Courtway Drive to Museum Road in Conway, Arkansas.

The successful Bidder must furnish a performance bond and a separate payment bond upon the forms provided in the amount of one hundred per cent (100%) of the contract price from an approved surety company holding a permit from the State of Arkansas to act as surety, or other surety or sureties acceptable to the Owner.

The attention of bidders is called to the fact that Act 150 of 1965 (as amended), Arkansas Statutes, states that a Contractor must be licensed by the State Licensing Board for Contractors before he may undertake work when the cost thereof in Arkansas is Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) or more.

Plans, specifications, proposal forms and other contract documents may be examined and obtained at the Mayor's Office, Conway City Hall, 1201 Oak Street, Conway, Arkansas (phone 501-450-6110). The charge for a set of plans and specification is \$25. No Refunds will be made.

Proposals will be considered on the basis of cost, the bidder's financial responsibility, his equipment, and his past performance in completing similar work. The City of Conway reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities, and to accept the proposal deemed to be for their best interest.
