

ORDINANCE NO, A- 344

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS; DECLARING THEM TO BE PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN SAID CITY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS

SECTION ONE (1). All streets within Parkwood Addition to the City of Conway, Arkansas, as shown on a plat of said Addition made by B. B. Brown, Registered Engineer, and recorded in Book of Town Plats, Volume "A," page 230, and designated as Rebecca Lane, Timothy Lane, Randolph Place, Mark Place and Jeffery Place, are hereby accepted by the City of Conway as public streets, and same are declared to be public streets and under the care, control and supervision of said City as of this date.

SECTION TWO (2). This ordinance being necessary for the protection of public property and for the public safety and general welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
