

ORDINANCE NO. A- 478

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION AND PAYMENT OF FEES TO THE DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

WHEREAS; it is hereby found and determined by the City Council of the City of Conway, Arkansas, that the work load of the office of City Attorney of the City of Conway, Arkansas, has steadily increased over the past three years; and

WHEREAS, the salary presently provided for such City Attorney **is** not sufficient to adequately compensate **said City Attorney for** his services; and

WHEREAS, unless the compensation of the City Attorney of the City of Conway, Arkansas **is** increased, the orderly and efficient administration of the affairs of said City and the administration of justice will be seriously hampered;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COIJNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. From and after February 1, 1969, the Municipal Court Judge shall assess additional costs against **a** person prosecuted by the City Attorney for violations of State laws committed within the corporate limits of the City of Conway, Arkansas, and for all violations of the ordinances of said City, provided, that such additional costs **so** assessed, do not exceed those which are allowed prosecuting attorneys in this State in criminal cases.

Section 2. The additional costs **so** assessed, shall be paid to the Deputy City Attorney of the City of Conway, Arkansas in monthly installments, payable at the end of each month for the month preceeding.

Section 3, All ordinances **or** parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance being necessary **for** the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Conway, Arkansas, an emergency is hereby declared to

exist and this ordinance shall be and become effective upon its passage and publication according to the terms and provisions hereof.
