

ORDINANCE NO. A-578

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS: DECLARING SUCH TERRITORY TO BE A PART OF SAID CITY: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY: AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, certain property owners lying adjacent to the City limits of Conway, Arkansas, did petition the Lounty Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, for an order annexing the hereinafter described territory to said City; and

WHEREAS, after proceedings being had upon notice by publication, all as provided by and in accordance with the laws of the State of Arkansas, the Judge of the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, did, on the 21st December, 1973, enter his order of annexation to said City of the hereinafter described lands:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of Conway, Arkansas, does hereby accept the hereinafter described territory, annexed to said City by order of the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, heretofore entered on the 21st December, 1973, said territory being described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 2, Township 5 North, Range 14 West, and run thence North 660 feet; run thence East 165 feet; thence South 660 feet to the South line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; run thence West 165 feet to the point of beginning; AND ALSO, Beginning at the Northwest Corner of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, Township 5 North, Range 14 West, run thence South 132 feet; thence East 495 feet; thence North 132 feet; thence West 495 feet to the point of beginning, and containing 4.5 acres, more or less.

And that said above described lands and territory be, and the same hereby are, declared to be a part of the City of Conway, Faulkner County, Arkansas.

SECTION 2. It is ascertained and declared that it is necessary for the protection and preservation of the public health and safety that the foregoing ordinance be **passed** and adopted; that an emergency exists; that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication,
