

ORDINANCE NO. 0-75-17

ORDINANCE TO AMEND RIGHT TURNS AT A RED LIGHT IN THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That from and after the passage of this Ordinance, vehicles approaching an intersection controlled by a stop light can, after first coming to a complete stop, and after ascertaining that the way is clear, make a right hand turn when the traffic light is red. Failure to first come to a complete stop, and failure to yield right-of-way to all traffic proceeding through said intersection, and in whose favor the traffic light is green, will subject the violator the same penalties as presently provided for by the Ordinance of the City of Conway, and the Laws of the State of Arkansas.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is not to be interpreted to in any way make the right-of-way of a person turning right on a red light after stopping and ascertaining that the way is clear, superior to that of a vehicle proceeding through the intersection with a green light, but, hereby specifically restricts and makes the right-of-way of said vehicle making a right hand turn on the red light, inferior to that of vehicles proceeding through the intersection with the green light.


SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance as set forth above, are hereby repelled.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance being necessary for the public safety and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in this Ordinance and it shall be enforced and take effect from and after its passage and publication.
