

ORDINANCE NO. -75- 23

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF ELIZABETH AVENUE TO CHRISITAN AVENUE: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY: AND FOR OTHER PUPROSES.

WHEREAS, It has been determined by the City Council of Conway, Arkansas that there are two (2) streets in Conway both of which are named Elizabeth which has been the cause of some confusion; and,

WHEREAS, The residents of Elizabeth Avenue, that one (1) block street running East and West between Watkins and Mitchell Street in the City of Conway desires unanimously to change the name of that street to Christian Avenue:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: That that street known as Elizabeth Avenue which is approximately one (1) block long running east and west between Watkins and Mitchell Street in the City of Conway, Arkansas is hereby named Christian Avenue, and that the new name of such street is to take effect from and after the passage of this ordinance.

Section 2: This ordinance being necessary for the public safety and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
