

ORDINANCE NO. 0-79-2

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR COURT APPEARANCE PAY FOR CONWAY CITY POLICEMEN DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section 1. Any uniformed employee of the Conway Police Department who is required to appear in Conway Municipal Court as a witness at a time when said employee is off-duty, shall be paid for two hours at said employee's regular rate of pay plus one-half of his regular rate of pay.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance being necessary for the public safety and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and shall take effect from and after its passage.
