

ORDINANCE NO. 0-82-22

ORDINANCE CLOSING AN ALLEY RUNNING BETWEEN LOTS 6, 9 and 10,  
DAVIDSON ADDITION TO THE CITY OF CONWAY, FAULKNER COUNTY,  
ARKANSAS, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

WHEREAS, the Petition was duly filed by James Clark, Dean Humphrey,  
and Bill Schlientz owners of said property, asking the City Council to  
close the alley lying between the following described tracts of land; and,

WHEREAS, a Resolution was adopted by the City Council calling for a  
public hearing to be held on the 10 day of August, 1982, and  
further said Resolution directed the Clerk to prepare the necessary notice;  
and,

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described alley has not been used by the  
City of Conway, or by the public generally or any one specifically for  
any purpose whatsoever, except for utility easements, in and around, under,  
through, or across said property, and that to vacate said alley would not  
interfere or cause any hardship upon the general public or the City of  
Conway;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION I: That the following described alley be and the same is  
hereby closed, abandoned and vacated by the City of Conway, Arkansas,  
to-wit:

That alley lying between Lots 6, 9 and 10 , Davidson  
Addition to the City of Conway, Faulkner County, Arkansas,  
as recorded in Plat Book \_\_\_\_\_ of the records of  
Faulkner County, Arkansas.

SECTION II: There will be utility easements to Conway Corporation,  
running through, across, under or over said alley.

SECTION III: Immediately after the passage and publication of this  
ordinance, it is to be filed with the Circuit Clerk and Ex-Officio Recorder  
of the Records in Faulkner County, Arkansas.

SECTION IV: That it being necessary for the public health, safety and  
welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall  
take effect and become effective immediately upon its passage and publication.
