

ORDINANCE O-97-22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SIGN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: That the definition of Portable Sign in Section Six Definitions of the Sign Ordinance of the City of Conway adopted by reference by Ordinance O-96-60 on the 9th day of July of 1996 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Portable Sign- Any sign designed to be moved easily and not permanently affixed to the ground or to a structure or building. Permanently affixed shall mean anchored to the ground as stipulated in Section 2303 Construction of the 1991 Edition of the Standard Building Code. For signs formerly utilized as portable signs, this anchoring shall, as a minimum, consist of no less than four concrete foundation pads no less than one square foot each in area and no less than 18 inches in depth with no less than 18 inches at or below grade and with the sign securely bolted or affixed to the concrete. For larger signs, the Administrator may require more substantial foundations and/or anchoring."

Section 2: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances of a permanent and general nature in effect at the time of adoption of this ordinance, and not included herein, are hereby repealed where they are in conflict with this ordinance.

Section 3: It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety of the City of Conway, Arkansas, and the inhabitants thereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason thereof this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
