

ORDINANCE NO. O-98-47

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

WHEREAS, the City of Conway is desirous of pursuing improvements in the Tucker Creek/Tupelo Bayou Levee in cooperation with the US Army Corps of Engineers; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence for the project, it is the desire of the City Council to appropriate its share for said improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:


SECTION 1. That the City of Conway is desirous of pursuing improvements to the Tucker Creek/Tupelo Bayou Levee in cooperation with the Corps of Engineers.


SECTION 2. The City does hereby appropriate \$93,500 from the Street Fund for its share of said improvements.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is necessary for the protection of the public pence, health and safety and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
