

ORDINANCE NO. 0-98-86

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING BIDS; APPROPRIATING FUNDS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

WHEREAS, the City of Conway is desirous of replacing three heat pump units with air conditioning units sized for areas to be served in City Hall; and

WHEREAS, Ramsey Service Company has experience with such units and the heating and air system in place at the City Hall; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence for the purchase, it is the desire of the City Council to waive bids and replace the heat pump units from the said service company.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Conway is desirous of replacing three heat pump units for City Hall.

SECTION 2. The City does hereby waive bids and approve the replacement of the said heat pump units for an amount not to exceed \$95,000 from Ramsey Service Company.

SECTION 3. The sum of \$95,000 is hereby transferred from Unappropriated General Fund Reserves to the Special Services budget for Building Maintenance.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance is necessary for the protection of the public peace, health, and safety and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
