**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE 2010 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ACTION PLAN; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Conway to allocate Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in such a manner that the maximum feasible priority is given to activities which will benefit low to moderate income families and eliminate slum and blight.

**WHEREAS**, there is an approximate total of \$435,000 in reserve for the Pine Street Neighborhood Revitalization Program;

**WHEREAS**, the Conway Interfaith Clinic presented a need for \$134,000 to renovate an existing building to accommodate a growing number of uninsured medical needs;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** The Annual Action Plan for 2010 is hereby amended to fund the Conway Interfaith Clinic (25.163.899) from funds previously allocated to the Pine Street Revitalization project (25.166.899) The Director of Community Development is authorized to submit the amendments to the 2010 Action Plan to the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

**SECTION 2:** The City of Conway shall transfer up to \$134,000 from 25.166.899, Pine Street Revitalization to 25.163.899, Interfaith Clinic.

**SECTION 3:** The 2010 CDBG Budget as submitted to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development shall be amended to reflect this change.

**SECTION 4:** Policies regarding Affirmative Action, Fair Housing, Davis-Bacon, Section 3 Employment, Environmental Concerns and all other federal, state and local laws shall be enforced on this project.

**SECTION 5:** This ordinance is necessary for the protection of the public peace, health and safety and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
