

RESOLUTION 77-5

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Conway, Arkansas by persons owning property abutting upon the hereinafter described street lying within Northwood Subdivision of the City of Conway, Arkansas, a more particularly description of said street being as follows:

Reeves Street lying within Northwood Subdivision described as follows: Begin at the Southeast corner of Lot 9, Block 1, Northwood Subdivision; run thence North along the East line of said Lot 9 a distance of 133.5 feet to the Northeast corner of said Lot 9; run thence East 50 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot 1, Block 2, Northwood Subdivision; run thence South along the West line of said Lot 1 a distance of 133.5 feet to the Southwest corner of said Lot 1; run thence West 50 feet to the Southeast corner of Lot 9, Block 1 and the point of beginning. ALSO: Begin at the Southeast corner of Lot 9, Block 4 Northwood Subdivision; run thence North along the East line of Lots 9 and 10, Block 4, Northwood Subdivision, a distance of 246.50 feet to the Northeast corner of Lot 10, Block 4; run thence East 50 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot 10, Block 3; run thence South along the West line of Lots 10 and 1, Block 3, 246.50 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 1, Block 3; run thence West 50 feet to the Southeast corner of Lot 9, Block 4 and the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, the Council finds that attached to said petition is a certified copy of the recorded plat, showing said street sought to be abandoned and vacated, and the lots abutting thereon:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

(1) That the City Council will hear said petition at its regular meeting to be held in the Council Chambers in the Municipal Building on the 10 day of May, 1977, at 6:30 o'clock p.m.

(2) That the Clerk-Treasurer is hereby directed to publish notice of the filing of said petition and of said hearing for the time and in the manner prescribed by law.
