


RESOLUTION NO. R-82-20

WHEREAS it has been brought to the attention of the City Council by the Parks and Recreation Department that there are encroachments upon City property in Gatlin Park, and such encroachments have hindered operation of Parks and Recreation Department,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS THAT:

Section 1. That all encroachments of whatever kind upon property of the City of Conway known as Gatlin Park shall forthwith be removed by whomever is maintaining said encroachment in violation of the property rights of the City of Conway, Arkansas. The mayor is hereby authorized and directed to take whatever action is necessary to remove said encroachments from property referred to as Gatlin Park.
