

RESOLUTION NO. R-86-10

WHEREAS, the Central Business District is a vital part of the business community of Conway; and

WHEREAS, The Retail Merchants Association and the Downtown Revitalization Committee of the Chamber of Commerce is actively pursuing improvements within the Central Business District to sidewalks and curbs and gutters; and

WHEREAS, the City of Conway with the purchase of the old First State Bank building for the new City Hall has shown a commitment to the Central Business District; and

WHEREAS, the City of Conway to further show its commitment to the Central Business District pledges to share in the sidewalk and curb and gutter revitalization cost with the property owners and merchants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

That the City of Conway wishes to make official its commitment of 1983 to share in one-half the cost of the revitalization of certain sidewalks and curbs and gutters in the Central Business District to a limit of \$195,300 conditioned upon the participation of all parties and inclusion of all sidewalks, curbs and gutters in a particular block in an area defined as the project area upon a map attached hereto and made a part of this resolution.
