

RESOLUTION NO. R-89- 09

WHEREAS, the Faulkner County Quorum Court will refer the issue of a proposed one cent county-wide sales tax to the voters in the near future; and

WHEREAS, the County is proposing that this tax be valid for one year only and that all proceeds be used solely for the construction of a new jail facility; and

WHEREAS, the County is requesting that all cities and towns in Faulkner County pass a resolution agreeing to transfer their monthly receipts of the sales tax, should it be approved, back to the County to be used solely for the construction of a new jail facility.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City of Conway hereby agrees to transfer its monthly receipts from this proposed tax back to Faulkner County for the purpose of construction of a new jail facility.


SECTION 2. This commitment is made contingent upon the County Sales Tax carrying the restrictions concerning the \$25 limit on single transactions as provided for by City Ordinance 0-81-42, Section 2; and Ordinance 0-83-17.
