

RESOLUTION R-98-30

WHEREAS, the City of Conway is making improvements to East German Lane from Oak Street to Wills Road and it is urgent to gain necessary right of way for the project; and

WHEREAS, certain of landowners whose lands abut upon the East German Lane improvements who have refused to execute and convey to the City the necessary right of way to permit such improvements to be made; and


WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Attorney will undertake to obtain and acquire the necessary rights of way for the construction and operation of said improvements if the City Council will authorize said officials to do so, and the Council desires to so authorize said officials.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

That the City Council does hereby authorize Mayor Kinley and City Attorney Murphy to proceed on the City's behalf to acquire from the owners thereof, through negotiations, exercise of the power of eminent domain, or by any other legal manner, such right of way across such lands as may be reasonably required for the improvements to East German Lane hereinabove described.
