



*Special City of Conway -- City Council Brief
May 23rd, 2006*

At its meeting the Conway City Council took the following actions:

Ordinances Passed:

- ◆ Ordinance {O-06-56} to close Bowie Street between West & Stout Street. **Vote 7-0 w/ Alderman Grimes absent from this meeting.**
- ◆ Ordinance {O-06-57} to close Fleming Street between Stout & West Street **Vote 6-1 w/ Adam Weeks voting against**
- ◆ Ordinance {O-06-58} accepting donations if offered and appropriating funds for infrastructure improvements in the Guy Murphy Industrial Park. **Vote 7-0**
- ◆ Ordinance {O-06-60} to rezone property located on the west side of Faulkner Street at the northwest corner of in the intersection of Robinson Avenue and Faulkner Street to R-2A to O-2. **Vote 7-0**
- ◆ Ordinance {O-06-61} to rezone property located at 1715 East Oak Street approximately 200 feet west of Milam Drive from R-1 to C-3. **Vote 7-0**
- ◆ Ordinance {O-06-62} to rezone property located at 1306 South Donaghey Avenue from R-1 to A-1. **Vote 7-0**
- ◆ Ordinance {O-06-63} authorizing acceptance of donations for Lake Beaverfork baseball field for the purpose of purchasing a scoreboard. **Vote 7-0**
- ◆ Ordinance {O-06-64} appropriating asset forfeiture funds to the Drug Task Force **Vote 7-0**
- ◆ Ordinance {O-06-65} appropriating animal welfare voluntary tax revenues to Animal Welfare Unit for special purchases. **Vote 7-0**
- ◆ Ordinance {O-06-66} accepting litigation settlement proceeds in conjunction with faulty armor vests for the CPD. **Vote 7-0**
- ◆ Ordinance {O-06-67} establishing requirements and standards and for excavation plan approval. **Vote 7-0**
- ◆ Ordinance {O-06-68} amending section 1 of O-06-51 to replace Debra Wilson by Jeffery Boucher on the Board of Civil Service Commissioners. **Vote 7-0**

Ordinances Failed:

- Ordinance {O-06-59} declaring a thirty date moratorium on the placement and/or permitting of any sign not in compliance with the proposed overlay district sign standards. *Vote 2-5 w/ Alderman Weeks & Hawkins voting for the ordinance.*

Resolutions Passed:

- Resolution {R-06-14} to set a public hearing to discuss the closing of a utility easement at property known as Lot 1 Lachowsky, 1110 Halter Road & 810 Amity Road. *Vote 7-0*
- Resolution (R-06-15} authorizing the Mayor to proceed with the acquisition of land for the new police department. *Vote 7-0*
- Resolution {R-06-16} to accept a proposal submitted by First State Bank for banking services and approving an agreement for those services. *Vote 7-0*
- Resolution {R-06-17} & agreement to enter into a contract with the YBMA to acquire property known as the "Fairgrounds". *Vote 7-0*
- Resolution {R-06-18} authorizing the Mayor to entering into contracts for the provision of architectural services for the police and fire departments. *Vote 7-0*

Resolutions Failed: None

Other actions:

In other actions, the Council:

- Approved a conditional use permit for an assist living level II facility (convalescent home) for the property located at 1306 South Donaghey Avenue. *Vote 7-0*
- Approved a conditional use permit for Trailer Sales for Lots 1, 2, & 3 of the J.R. Properties Addition located at 325 J.R. Drive. *Vote 7-0*
- Approved speed humps for Bridgestone Subdivision & Westin Estates. *Vote 7-0*
- Approved playground equipment at Lake Beavorfork & Gatling Park from Arkoma for the Conway Parks & Recreation Dept. *Vote 7-0*

HELD IN COMMITTEE/NO ACTION TAKEN

- Ordinance (O-06-42) repealing the City of Conway Uniformed Employee's Code (Ordinance O-01-13) and all related codes, ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations.
